
Structure of German Operational Programmes

1 national ESF OP






Effects of COVID-19 Pandemic in Germany

Percent



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



German Stimulus Package not Channelled via Structural Funds

National stimulus has a significant higher volume than NGEU and REACT EU

National stimulus includes:

- Multibillion-euro assistance programmes
- Tax-related assistance measures
- Furlough /Short-time work
- Joint crisis management at international level (G7, G20, Eurogroup)







SME targeted by intervention







100% of energy consumption could have been met by regional renewable energy production. However, energy has been exported to other regions





Priority 4 – Sustainable rural / urban development


- Investments in line with integrated urban planning

The 2021-2027 period: JTF – Blessing or Curse

Coal Fired Energy production


- Indicative planning to phaseout coal fired energy production until 2038
- Federal government published Act on Structural Change in Coal Mining Areas
- 40 bn. Euro for mining areas to support the transition
- 2.3 bn. Euro additional of Just Transition Fund for Germany





The 2021-2027 period: JTF – Blessing or Curse

German federal government decided to use JTF for budget consolidation





JTF support decreases federal support

1 Euro JTF vs. 0.85 Euro federal support
